- Complete a language screener to find your AAC learner's language level
- Download lesson plans and activities to support that level
- Teach literacy with the Getting Ready to Read programs

**What is it?**  
An online service that uses data logging on a speech-generating device/app to collect, organize, and display info about words that the AAC learner uses.  
Subscription Fee: \$10.00 per year

**Who is it for?**  
Parents/families, SLPs, and educators who want to learn more about how an AAC Learner is using language on the SGD/app.

**How can I use it?**

- Learn the most frequently used words and word types
- See the time of the day words are used
- Find out if the AAC learner is trying to spell words
- Create a custom word list for the AAC learner and see how often they are used
- Monitor progress over a specific time period
