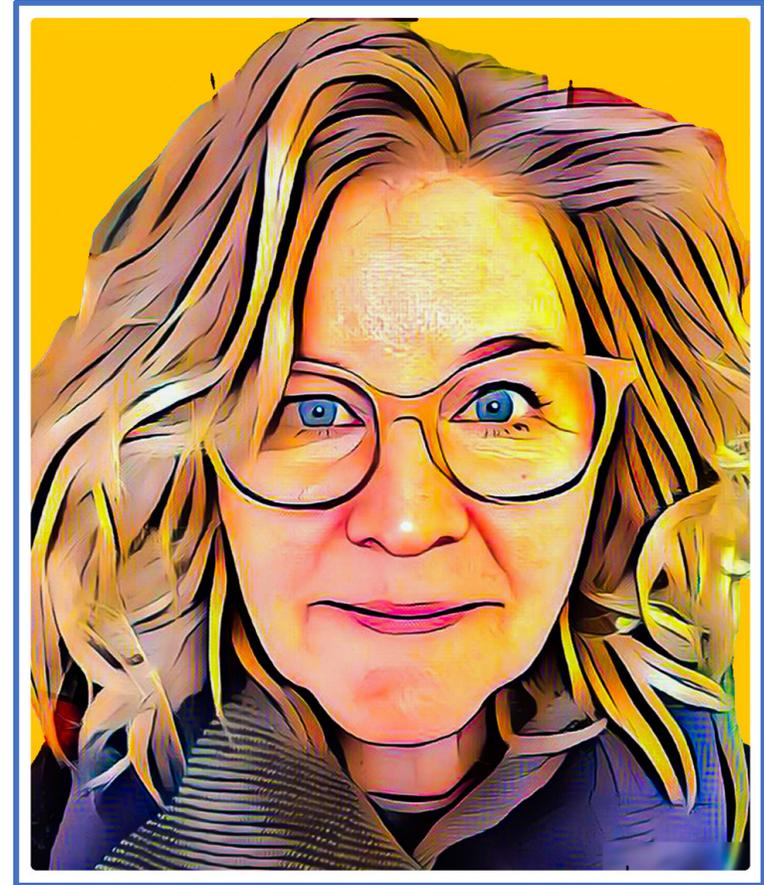

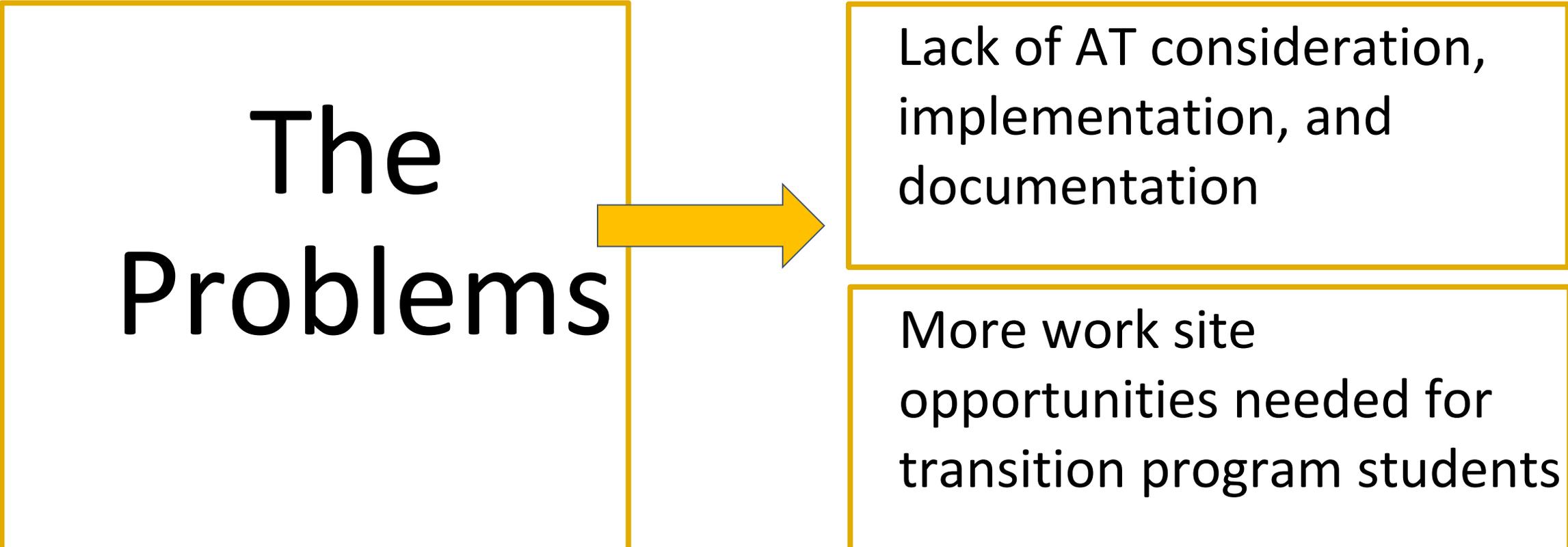

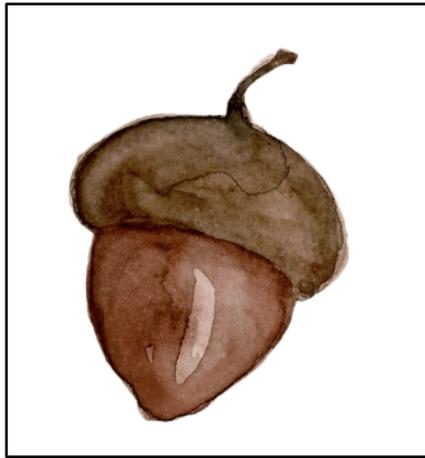

- Wide variety of skills

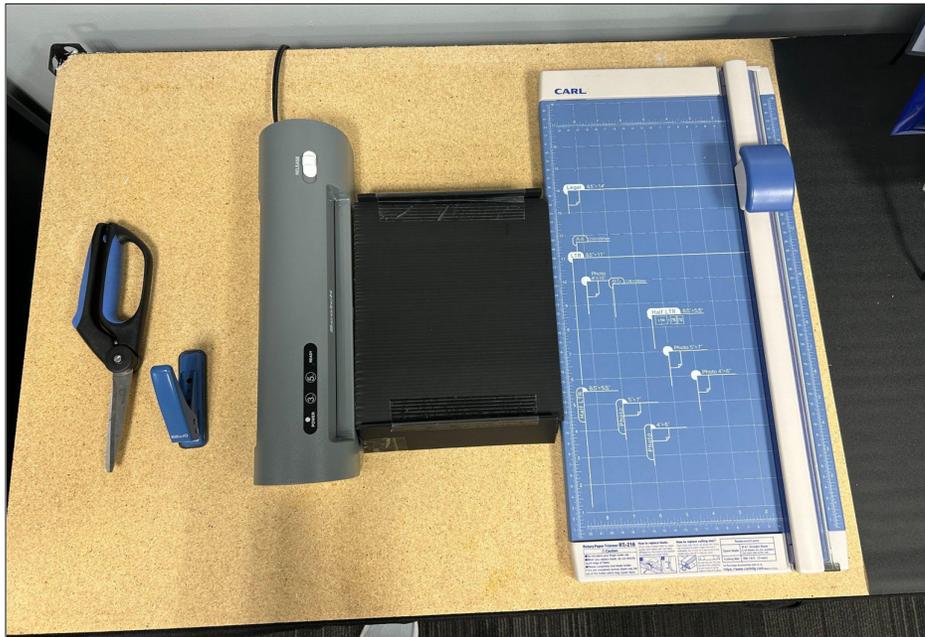

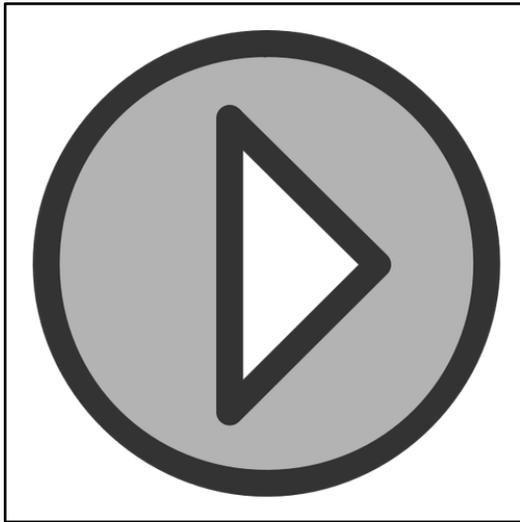
Environmental Modifications and Supports Cont.

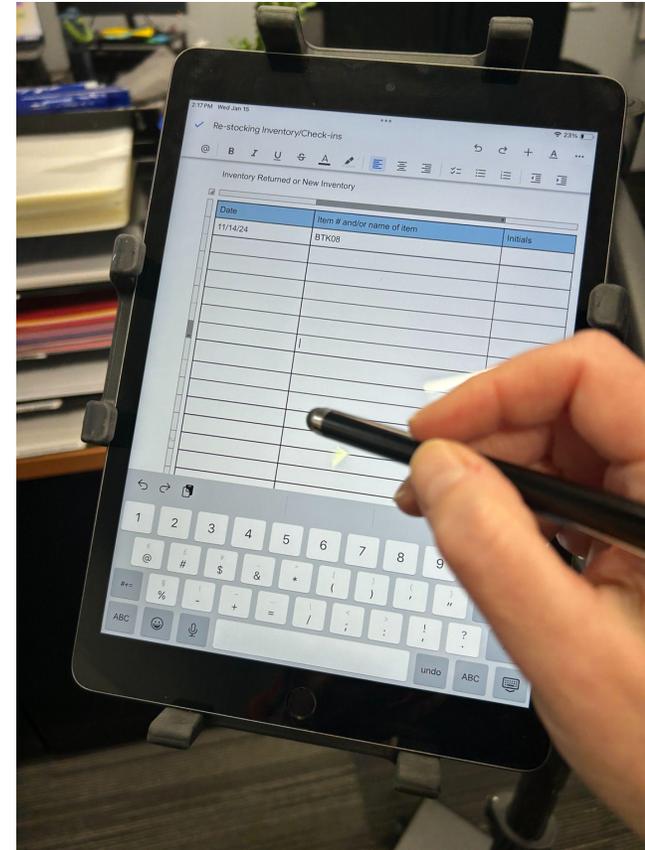

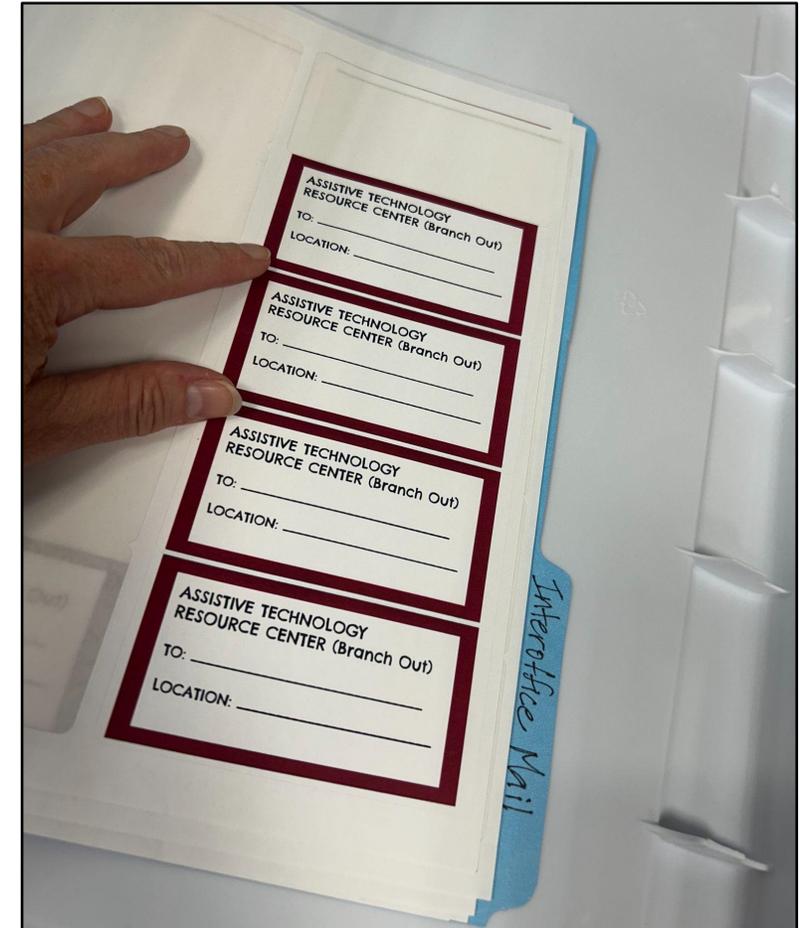
AT Lending Library Work

Visual Production Work

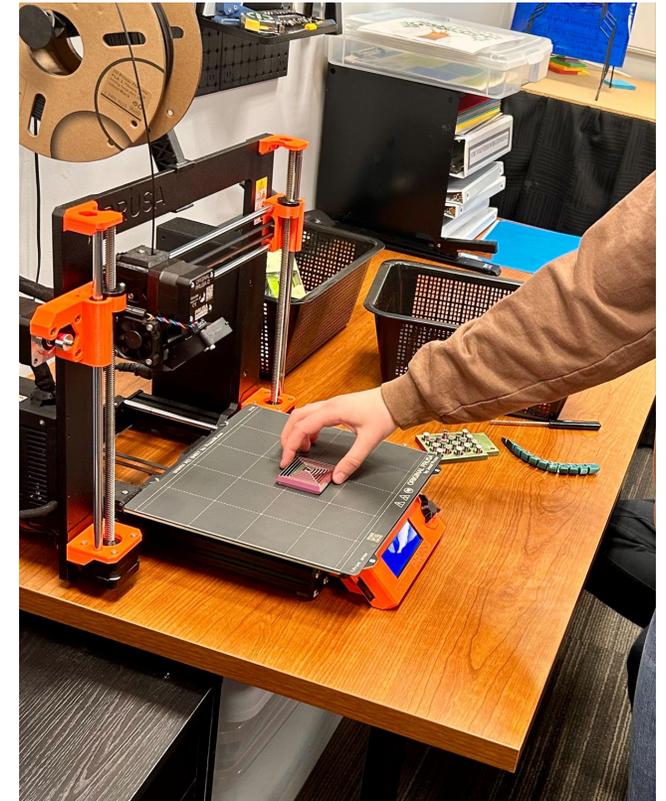
- Visual schedules

- Custom orders



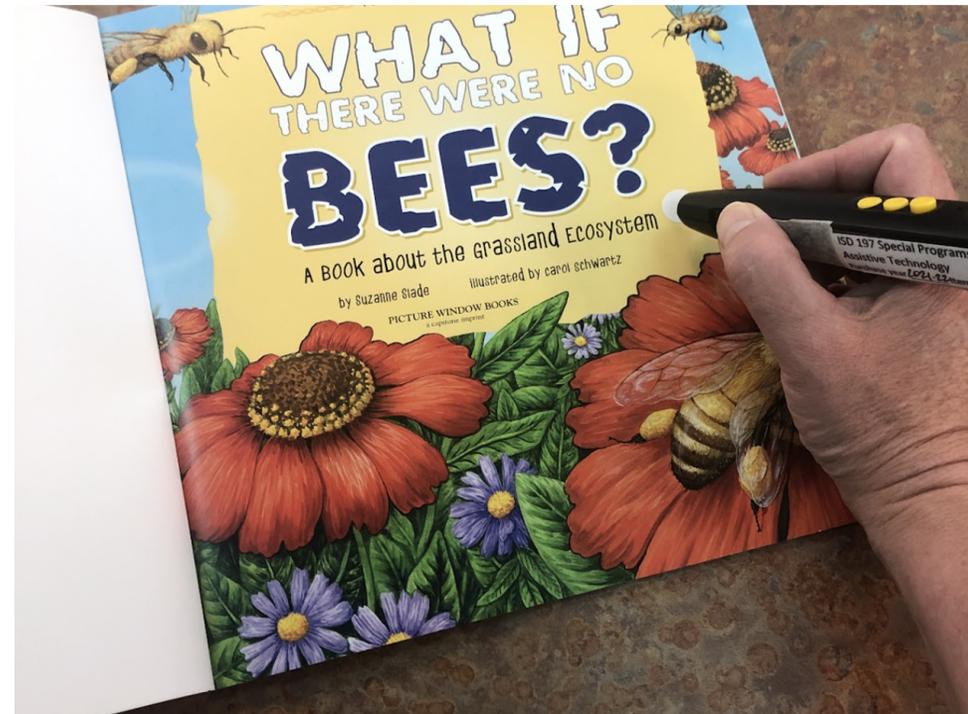
Low-Tech Fabrication Work

- Weighted pencils

What's Next / Future Planning?

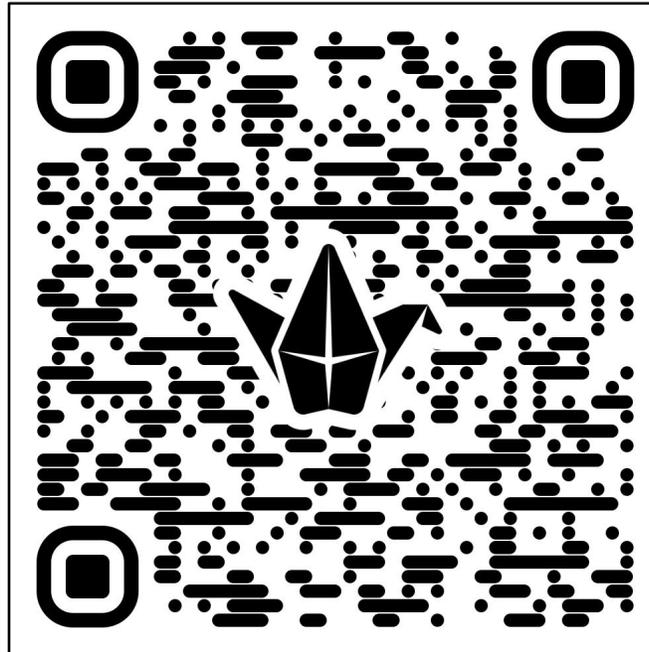
General goals for the future involve the creation of tools and resources to support literacy across the district.
