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What is Autism Navigator?

Autism Navigator is a web-based instructional program developed by the Florida State University Autism Institute to increase the capacity of primary care, early intervention, and other service providers, as well as families, to better serve young children with or at risk for autism spectrum disorder (ASD).

- Collection of online resources and tools
- The courses are separated based on service delivery, ages and settings.

What is Best Practice in Early Intervention

We know that **best practice** in Early Intervention is the coaching model also known as the Evidence-based Quality Intervention Practices (EQIP) Coaching Model

Why Autism Navigator?

- Evidence-based
- Builds professionals' capacity in Autism Spectrum Disorder and their ability to help families

Service Delivery:

- Coaching
- Variety of providers based on need
- Observation, support
- Home-based/daycare, natural environments in the community
- Routines, activities, interests

Why early detection is important

Far better impact on:
intellectual ability placement for
kindergarten

Core diagnostic features of autism:

- Impaired social communication and interaction
- Restricted, repetitive patterns of behaviors

Tools/ Resources:

- Communication and Symbolic Behavior Scales Developmental Profile (CSBS)
- The Systematic Observation of Red Flags of Autism Spectrum Disorder (SORF)



Unit 2: Collaborating with Families

- Central role of the family in the early identification and intervention process

*This unit helps providers support family's knowledge and impact of ASD

Unit 3: Developmental Perspectives

- Natural Environment: How people and activities help learning
- Developmental Trajectories for: Play, Social Communication, Language, and Emotional Regulation

Unit 4: Evidenced-Based Intervention Strategies

- Intervention outcome priorities in ASD
- What teaches parents?
- How do we coach them?
- Monitoring progress

Unit 5: Addressing Challenging Behaviors

- Understanding the impact that ASD has on a child's responses and relationships resulting in challenging behaviors:
- Deepening your understanding of:
 - core deficits of ASD
 - collaborating with families
 - developmental perspectives
 - Evidence-Based Intervention Strategies
