Why Coaching?

Positive outcomes of coaching:

- Increased implementation of Evidence-Based-Practices
- Changes in teaching practices
- Teachers feel supported and open to trying new strategies

Coaching and assistive technology?

Increased confidence and capacity in all adults leads to:

- Increased effective and consistent use of assistive technology
- Increased participation and engagement of children
- Increased learning outcomes

Getting started with coaching: Teaching practices

- Provide a defined set of practices.
- Provide opportunities for learners to identify strengths and needs related to the practices.

Example Teaching Practices: Step Up AT

- Step Up AT Teacher Strengths and Needs Assessment.
- You can find this at stepupat.org. Go to the Resources tab and scroll down to Coaching Resources.

Example practices:

- Make it easier for children to join in classroom activities by giving them switches and other tools.
- Use pictures or talking tools to help children communicate.

Example Teaching practices: Augmentative and Alternative communication (AAC)

Create a list of practices from sources such as this article from Assistiveware:

- I model a variety of communicative functions using their system during everyday activities and routines.
 - I use parallel talk while using the child's system
 - I use self talk while using the child's system
 - I narrate navigation while modeling
- I use an expectant pause to create communication opportunities.
- I attribute meaning to any communication attempts.
- I add more words or ideas to children's communication attempts.

Getting Started: Make a plan

- Identify a practice as a focus
- Collaborate to develop a plan
- Document the plan
- Provide enough details so roles are clear

Coaching Strategy: Create a coaching toolkit

For each practice, collect and organize the following:

- Learn more about it resources
- Illustrations of the practice
- Implementation supports

Coaching Toolkit: Learn more about it

Knowledge, skills, theoretical foundations, why.

- Define the important components of the practice
- Provide illustrations of the practice
- Provide examples and non-examples
- Use short videos, articles and infographics

Coaching Toolkit: Develop implementation supports

Help learners remember what they have learned, what they need to do and when to do it by using implementation supports such as:

- Matrices
- Implementation checklists
- Scripts
- Tip sheets
- Visual supports
- Memes and infographics

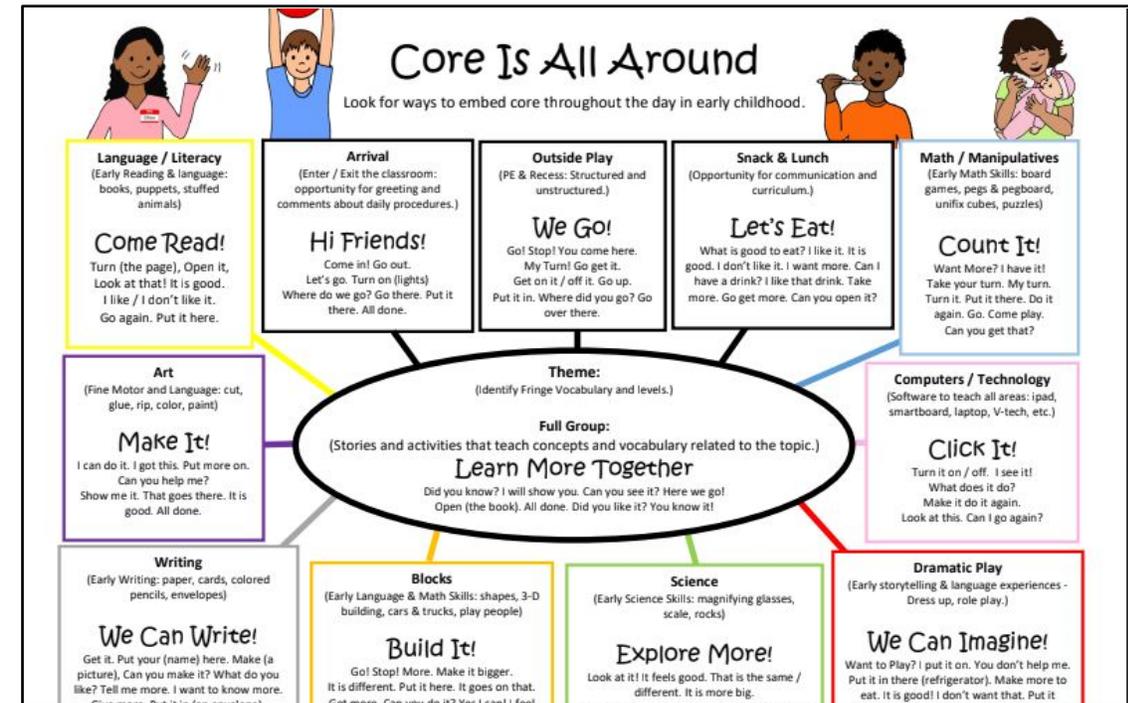

- Helps adults identify when to use the practice
- This one includes target words and scripts

Coaching Strategy: Rehearse

Rehearse

- Practice
- Role play
- Reflect and problem Solve

Coaching Strategy: Model

Effective modeling:

- Discuss the plan for modeling with the learner
- Explain what you will be doing and why
- Give the learner a job
- Reflect

Coaching strategy: Observation

Coach observes the teacher implementing the practice at an agreed upon time.

Make a plan for the observation:

- What data will the coach collect?
- What will the coach watch for?
- What real time support might be provided? (gestural cues, verbal cues)

Coaching strategy: Reflection

Provide opportunities for the teacher to reflect on their implementation of the practice.

- What went well?
- How did that feel?
- What was challenging?
- What did you notice when...?
- What would you keep the same, change?

Coaching strategy: Feedback

Feedback is:

- Focused
- Specific
- Supportive and constructive

Feedback Tips and Strategies

- I Notice Statements
 - Supportive: I noticed that you xxxx and this is a great example of xxxx.
 - Supportive: I noticed that you xxx and this is important because xxx.
 - Constructive: I noticed xxx, some strategies you might consider are xxx.
 - Constructive: I noticed xxx, something you might try is....
- Use language of teaching and learning familiar to your team
- Keep suggestions specific and simple
- Feedback can be provided in written form, emails, notes

My coaching action plan

What are your next steps?

- Find practices, create lists of practices
- Create, find and display easily understood visuals
- Collect and share videos of amazing implementation in practice
- Collect and organize articles and videos of the practices
- Record others using the practices
- Learn more about reflection and feedback
- Try out some feedback starters
- Plan rehearsal or modeling
- Explore the Step Up AT website
